NOTICE OF COUNTY GENERAL AND STATE PRIMARY ELECTION
THURSDAY, AUGUST 4, 2016

Notice is hereby given that an election will be held in all voting precincts of Union County on Thursday, August 4, 2016 for the purpose of conducting the following elections:

GENERAL ELECTION – For the purpose of electing a Property Assessor, a Highway Superintendent for four year terms each, one (1) County Commissioner from the second and fourth county commission districts each, to serve the remainder of the 2014-2018 term, one (1) School Board Member each from the first, second, third, fourth and sixth districts; all school board seats are for four years, except the third district which is to serve the remainder of the 2014-2018 term; one (1) Constable each from county commission districts 6 and 7, one (1) Road Commissioner from the fourth county commission district to serve the remainder of the 2014-2018 term each.

DEMOCRATIC PRIMARY – For the purpose of nominating a U.S. House of Representative from the 3rd Congressional District for a two (2) year term, a Tennessee State Senate from the 8th State Senate District, a Tennessee House of Representatives – one each for House Seat 35 and House Seat 36.

REPUBLICAN PRIMARY - For the purpose of nominating a U.S. House of Representative from the 3rd Congressional District for a two (2) year term, a Tennessee State Senate from the 8th State Senate District, a Tennessee House of Representatives – one each for House Seat 35 and House Seat 36.

The Early Voting period begins Friday, July 15, 2016 and goes through Saturday, July 30, 2016. The voting hours are from 9:00 am to Noon Monday through Saturday. All Early Voting is conducted at Union County High School, Main Street, Maynardville, TN, 37807. Voters should park and enter at the north side entrance.

Pre-inspection of the voting machines will be held on Wednesday, July 13, 2016 at 10:00 am at the Election Commission office in Suite 108 of the courthouse in Maynardville.

Deadline to register to vote or change your name or address on an existing registration in person at the Election Commission office is July 5, 2016. Voters who have not notified the Election Commission Office of a name/address change may experience a delay in voting. Mail-in registration applications must be postmarked no later than July 5, 2016. Registration applications are available at the Election Commission Office, or may be downloaded and printed from the website at www.electionsunioncountyttn.com.

Elderly voters and voters with disabilities who are assigned to vote in precincts where the polling place is inaccessible may vote early during the regular early voting dates or by an absentee ballot by mail, or may vote at the Election Commission office on Election Day. ***Absentee ballots by mail may be requested from May 6, 2016 through July 28, 2016.***

Any elderly voter or voter with a disability desiring to vote at the Election Commission Office on Election Day, Thursday, August 4, 2016 must notify the Election Commission

Office in writing by July 25, 2016. Appropriate forms may be obtained at the Election Commission Office, or by calling 865-992-3471.

Regular office hours are 8:00 am – 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday.
