The regular city election for the City of Luttrell will be held on Thursday, June 1, 2017 at the Luttrell Community Center located at 115 Park Road, Luttrell, TN 37779. The purpose for this election will be to elect a Mayor for a two year term; and two City Council members for four year terms each.

The registration deadline, including non-resident property owner registrations, is Tuesday, May 2, 2017.

Pursuant to TCA §2-6-102(b)(1), there will be NO Early Voting Period for this election.

Elderly voters and voters with disabilities may vote by an absentee ballot by mail. **Absentee by mail ballots may be requested through May 25, 2017. ANYONE 60 YRS. AND OLDER MAY REQUEST AN ABSENTEE BALLOT BY MAIL.** Any elderly voter and voter with a disability desiring to vote at the Election Commission Office on Election Day, Thursday, June 1, 2017 must notify the Election Commission Office in writing by May 22, 2017. Appropriate forms may be obtained at the Election Commission Office, or by calling the office at 865-992-3471.

As requested by the City of Luttrell and allowed by TCA §2-9-109(b) all voting will be done with paper ballots.

Federal or Tennessee state government issued photo ID is now required to vote, unless an exception applies. College student Ids will not be accepted. To learn more about the new law and its exceptions, please call 865-992-3471 or visit GoVoteTN.com.
