

**VOTE EARLY!
And Skip the Line**

This November 8 Election Day is expected to be a busy day, and in order to avoid standing in line on Election Day voters are encouraged to take advantage of Early Voting. Early voting will be conducted from October 19 through November 3 Mondays through Saturdays. The hours for early voting in Union County are 9:00 am to Noon from October 19 through October 29 and from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm October 31 through November 3. All Early Voting will be conducted in the small courtroom of the courthouse located at 901 Main Street in Maynardville.

Absentee by mail voting is also available to eligible voters who are physically unable to get to their polling place, or who are caregivers. Voters over the age of 60, as well as college students living outside the county may also be eligible to vote absentee by mail.

The easiest way for voters to find Election Day polling locations, view and mark sample ballots, see their elected officials, districts and county election commission information as well as access online state and federal election results is through the **GoVoteTNapp**. Voters can download the free app in the App Store or Google Play or visit **GoVoteTN.com** to view voter specific information.

Voters who have moved or who have changed their names are encouraged to make sure all information is correct on their voter registration. Voters may come by the Election Commission office or call 865-992-3471 Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. The office is located in Suite 108 of the courthouse in Maynardville. Voters may also visit **GoVoteTN.com** to check registration status, or www.electionsunioncountyttn.com for additional information. The deadline for registration is October 11.
